

WHEN STUDENT BEHAVIOR INTERRUPTS LEARNING

At Bayhill we have a saying, "if a student prevents a teacher from teaching or another student from learning, then they are not a Bayhill student." We take that very seriously, but we also know that after a year and a half of a pandemic and distance learning, students needed a period of adjustment. Teachers and administrators have provide varying interventions to get some of our students back on track with behavior. However, as we move into quarter 2, we are going to be cracking down a bit more.

Disruptive students will be sent out of class if they do not respond to teacher redirection. Students sent out of class could face loss of off campus privileges or may be "invited" to spend lunch with an administrator. We will also be sending word home, and we hope parents will partner with us to insure all students are learning.

PROOF OF VACCINATION REQUIRED FOR MOST FIELD TRIPS

Remember that all Bay Area Counties require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test within 72 hours for museums and other indoor venues. We have field trips starting the first week of November for math and science.

As we usually pre-buy tickets, we will need proof of vaccination on file so we can provide them to the vendor when we buy the tickets.

SPORTS STARTING SOON - VACCINATION REQUIRED



TEACHER IN-SERVICE DAY ADDED

Every year we schedule three extra days into the school calendar to account for school closures due to fires or other unforeseen events. Due to a fire-free first quarter, we have decided to schedule a teacher in-service day on October 22.

Students will NOT come to school on that day. Teachers will be at work for professional development and collaboration.

WHEN TO KEEP STUDENTS HOME

If your child has any of the following symptoms, please do NOT send them to school.

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Runny nose or congestion
- Loss of taste or smell
- Persistent headache
- Shortness of breath

When any of these symptoms are present, students must get a negative PCR COVID test in order to return to school. Home tests are NOT acceptable.

Consider using <https://www.testthepeople.org/>. Walk-ups with no appointments are accepted and results are returned in less than 24 hours. They take all insurance. If you use your primary care provider, expect to wait for an appointment plus 2-3 days for results.

If you are out awaiting COVID results, contact your case manager to set up a period of Zoom/day with Ms. Garner to get help on assignments and be counted as present.
