Are you looking for an opportunity for your child to receive the 30 hours of driver's training instruction and 6 hours behind the wheel? A few of our students have been successful with the instruction of Moira Motil.

At this time, all of the Bayhill students who have studied with Moira and taken the DMV written test have successfully passed it, received their permit to practice, are practicing driver's training, and well on their way to getting their driver's license. Many, now do have their driver's license.

PROOF OF VACCINATION REQUIRED FOR MOST FIELD TRIPS

Remember that all Bay Area Counties require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test within 72 hours for museums and other indoor venues. We have field trips starting the first week of November for math and science.

To help students out, we will bring the vaccination cards we have on file. Others need to remember to bring their card or negative test.

WHEN TO KEEP STUDENTS HOME

If your child has any of the following symptoms, please do NOT send them to school.

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Runny nose or congestion
- Loss of taste or smell
- Persistent headache
- Shortness of breath

When any of these symptoms are present, students must get a negative PCR COVID test in order to return to school. Home tests are NOT acceptable.

Consider using <https://www.testthepeople.org/>. Walk-ups with no appointments are accepted and results are returned in less than 24 hours. They take all insurance. If you use your primary care provider, expect to wait for an appointment plus 2-3 days for results.

If you are out awaiting COVID results, contact your case manager to set up a period of Zoom/day with Ms. Garner to get help on assignments and be counted as present.
