

# Give Big

Bayhill's Annual Fund is underway and we hope our donors Give Big. You may have noticed some security improvements around the school – Airtight Construction donated a new gate around our courtyard. We also had a beautiful stained glass gate with a locking pad installed at the entrance to the church courtyard which cost Bayhill over \$100,000. The electrical in the annex was updated this summer and we passed our fire inspection with flying colors.

More improvements are needed to secure the school and we are hoping to raise at least \$60,000. Our next big project includes installing an automatic locking door and camera system at the entrance to the school that will allow us to keep our front doors locked at all times. We also need an updated phone and intercom system throughout the school, which requires upgrades to our broadband network.
