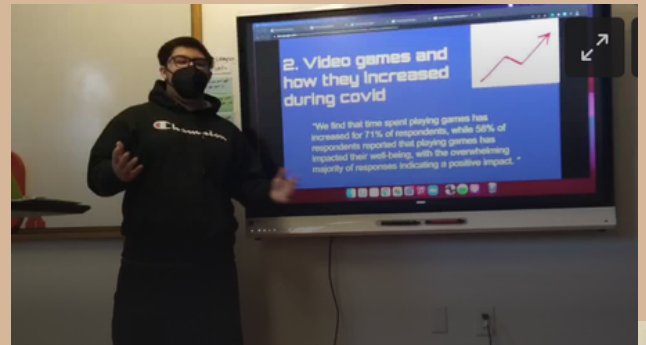


JOIN OUR BOARD

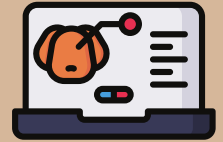
